**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEE COLLECTIVE
BARGAINING AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Teamsters Local No. 320 (Teamsters) is the exclusive representative for certain maintenance employees ("the bargaining unit) employed by the City of Waite Park ("the City); and

WHEREAS, the collective bargaining agreement by and between the City and Maintenance Employees expired December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City and the bargaining unit have met and negotiated terms of the new collective bargaining agreements for the Maintenance Employees and have reached a tentative agreement that will be effective, if approved, January 1, 2021 and will expire December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the attached Exhibit A is the proposed collective bargaining agreement that has been approved by the Maintenance Employees; and

WHEREAS, the proposed collective bargaining agreement sets forth changes to the terms and conditions of employment that have already been discussed and reviewed by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Waite Park that we adopt the resolution and approve the attached collective bargaining agreement between the City of Waite Park and Teamsters Local No. 320 Maintenance Employee Members; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the Mayor and the City Administrator to execute the attached collective bargaining unit accepting the proposed changes to the collective bargaining unit shown in italics.
